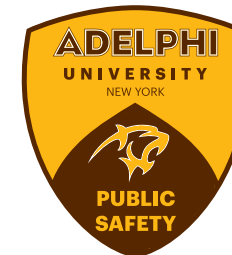

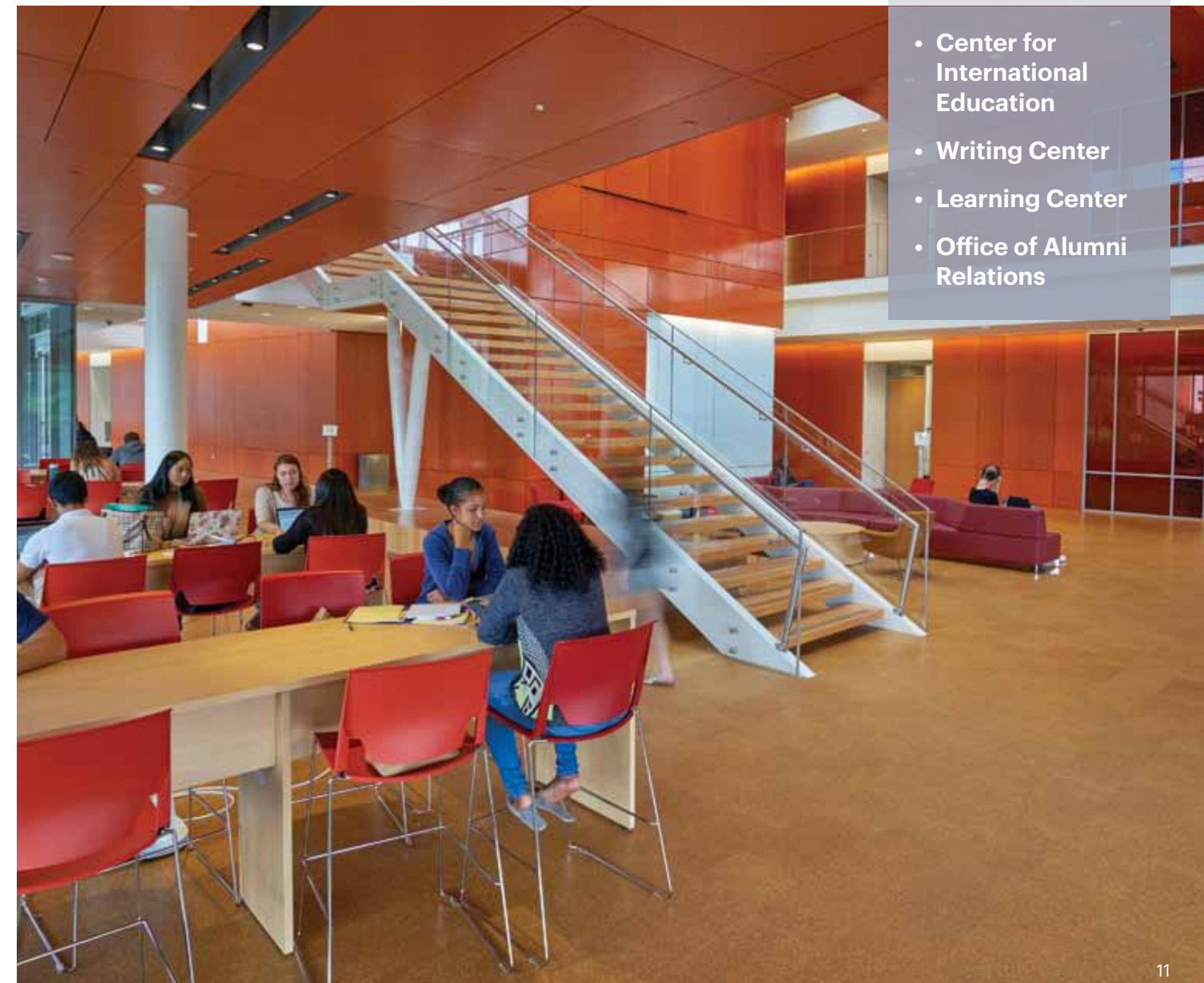

Meet **Abhijeet Muzumdar**, Head of Private Investments and Corporate Development at Amazon, M.B.A. '04.

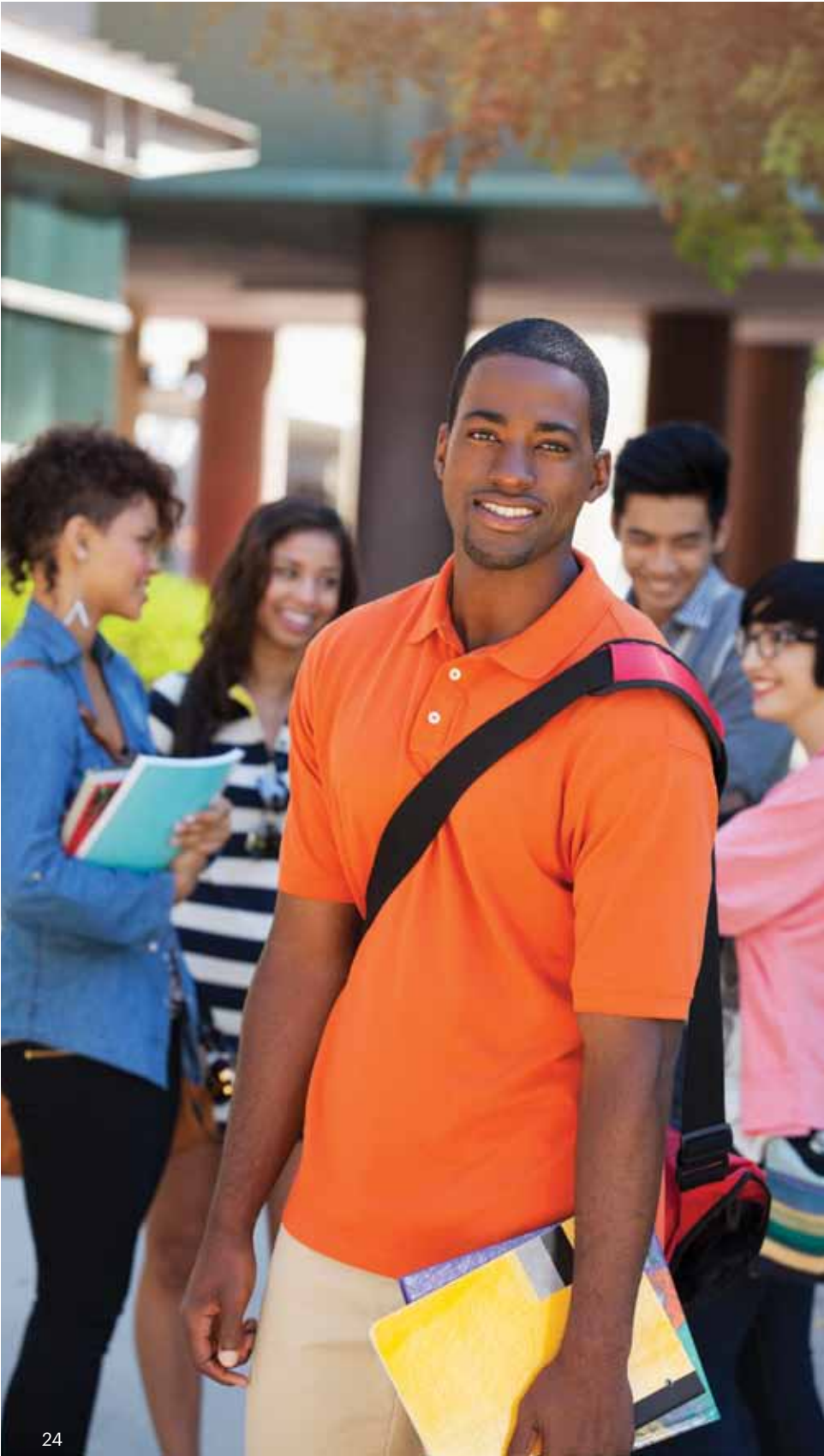

HOUSING

Adelphi International has a variety of on-campus housing options for undergraduate students. Adelphi International students are required to live in program-approved housing for the duration of their program. All housing offerings are fully furnished and include cable and WiFi service, in-building laundry and kitchen access. Student safety and peace of mind are emphasized across each housing offering. Applicants will need to visit aui.adelphi.edu/housing to indicate their housing preference prior to arrival. All housing options include:

- 24/7 campus or building security
- Keycard building access and keycard or key room access
- Live-in resident assistants or student life staff

On-Campus Housing

All undergraduate students will choose from one of seven (Options A-G) room types, including a variety of triple-occupancy rooms and double-occupancy rooms, with the option to choose rooms with A/C or without (for a reduced price). Please note that students who live on campus may need to move to another housing type during the summer semester.

Student Dining: Adelphi International

Adelphi Dining Services offers a variety of options. You can purchase food in a variety of locations across campus offering a wide selection of options including pizza, ethnic foods, traditional and wrap-style sandwiches, burgers, chicken sandwiches, grab-and-go package meals, salads and homemade desserts are available. If you are in the mood for something else, you can also visit Panther Melts, the Legends Juice Bar, Paws Café or Post Hall.

Post Hall Dining

Post Hall, located directly below the Adelphi International office, is an all-you-care-to-eat dining location that serves high-quality food, all made from scratch. Post Hall serves breakfast all day, as well as burgers, sandwiches, salads, seafood, vegetarian options, steaks and so much more. Students with meal plans also have access to free all-day Sunday brunch!

Panther Mart

The Panther Mart, located within Post Hall Dining, sells fresh produce, fresh grab-and-go sandwiches, Starbucks coffee and an assortment of other products.

Meal plans provide an allocation of meals and Panther Dollars per semester, which can be used by swiping your student ID for à la carte food purchases. During winter break and the summer semester, the UC Café will remain open, although hours may be limited.

Dining Plan

12 Meals/Week (on campus)

Students living on campus will be required to purchase a standard meal plan (12 meals per week and \$250 in Panther Dollars). All students have the ability to upgrade their meal plan to include more meals per week.

Summer Meal Plan

Students living on campus during the summer semester will be required to purchase a reduced meal plan during the summer semester. A set amount of Panther Dollars will be added to the ID card for students to purchase meals on campus. Students are also welcome to add more money to their cards if needed.



Admissions

Adelphi University offers a simple, streamlined admissions process that includes a variety of outcomes designed to ensure your success inside and outside of the classroom. The admissions outcome that is best for you will depend on your academic qualifications, English-language level and personal preferences.

Students applying to Adelphi University will benefit from:

Streamlined Application Process

Submit a simple application and receive the university's decision within one week.

- Deposit that is listed on your conditional offer
- If you are currently studying in the United States and will be transferring your I-20, you also will need to submit the current I-20 and the SEVIS Transfer Form.
