Campus Safety

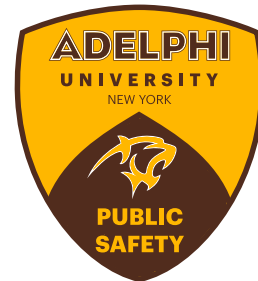

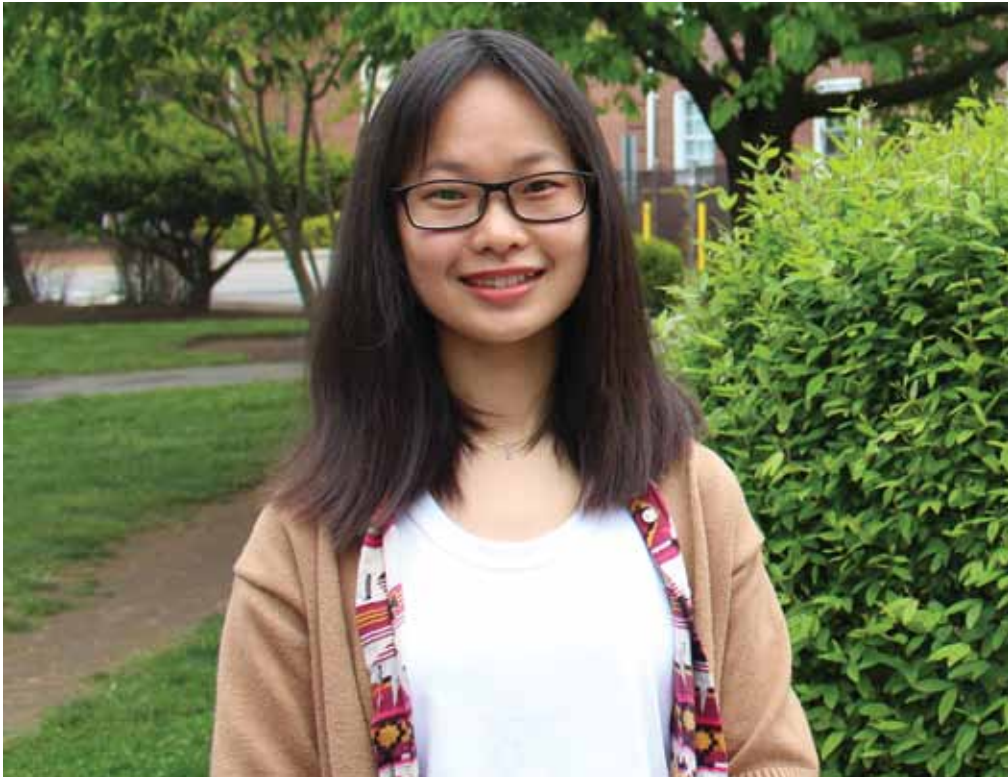

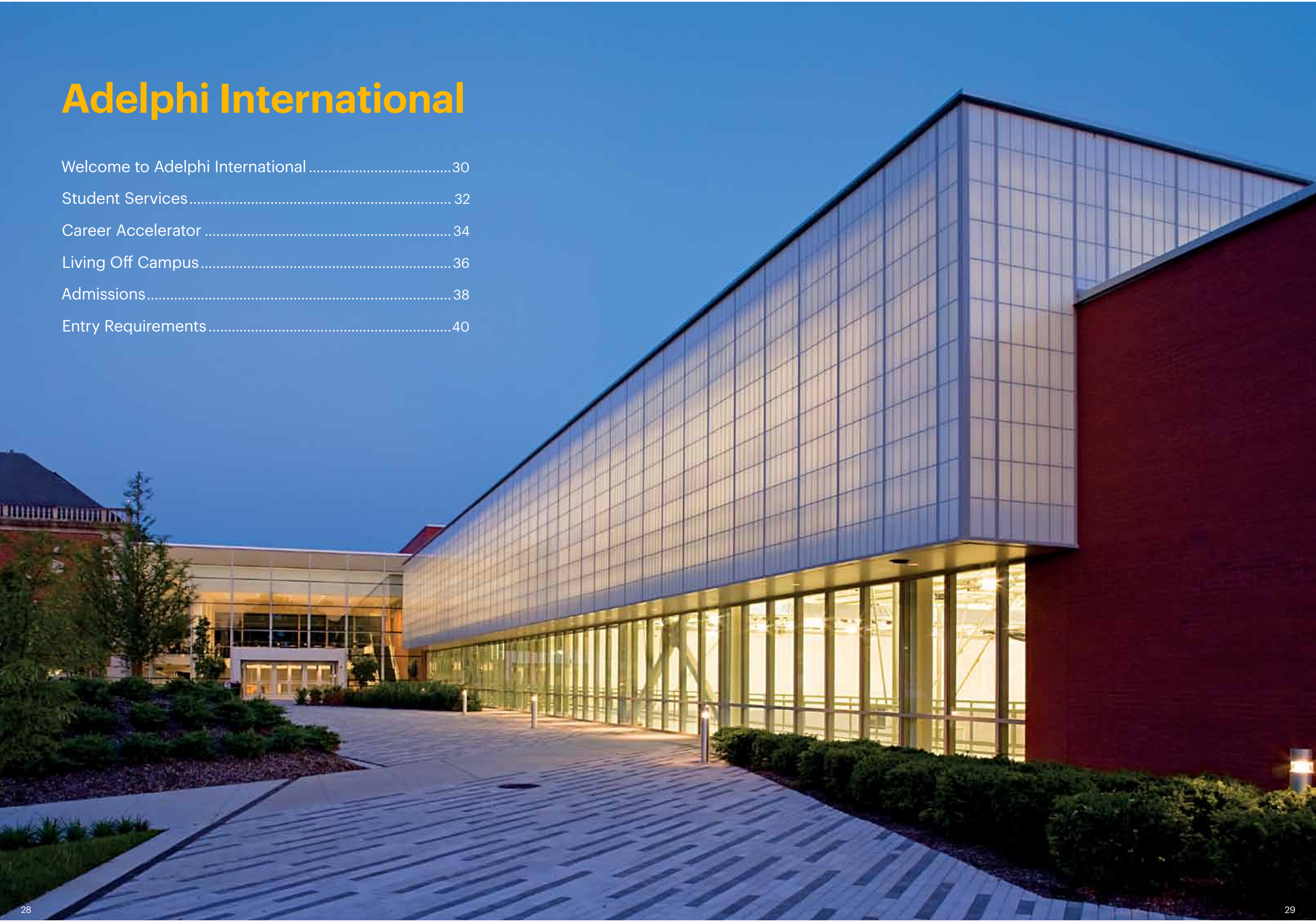
